The Cisco International Internship Program (CIIP) is a once-in-a-lifetime year-long opportunity for high-performing students, from a variety of leading international universities. Selected students will experience working at Cisco's headquarters, in the heart of Silicon Valley!

We offer internships across the company, but we make sure managers give our CIIP interns time for stretch projects, and we stretch them hard! Prerequisites

To apply for a CIIP internship, target candidates should be:

- Pursuing a relevant undergraduate degree, and have
 1-year of additional schooling to complete, post-CIIP
- Studying at an accredited international University
- Able to demonstrate strong academic proficiency
- Fluent in English
- Able to obtain, or have, a passport valid for the duration of the internship
- Available to live and work in the U.S. for 12-months
- Willing to undergo the J-1 Visa obtainment process
- A non-Cisco employee
